

ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP **AMERICORPS SERVICE POSITION**

The Armstrong Conservation District (ACD) is seeking one (1) Pennsylvania Mountain Service-AmeriCorps member to serve a 1700-hour service position (~37 hours/week) from September 1, 2026 to August 14, 2027. This position will receive a bi-weekly stipend of \$955.00 throughout the service term, healthcare insurance if needed at no charge, an income eligible child-care stipend if qualified, and an education stipend of \$7,395 upon successful completion of term. Job Description:

- Assist ACD staff with the implementation of the ACD technical programs: Agriculture, Watershed, Erosion & Sediment Control and Dirt, Gravel, Low Volume Roads (DGLVR) programs.
- Plan and coordinate, along with ACD staff, various education and outreach opportunities such as the Mobile Environmental Display (MED), workshops and field days, as well as other planned events - Envirothon, Fall Tour, Elected Officials Breakfast, Tree Sale, and Arbor Day.
- Maintain the ACD Water GeoTrail.
- Contribute to the daily operations of the new Agricultural Education Center which includes weekends and possible evening hours.
- Provide assistance to the ACD District Manager and ACD staff with general administrative duties and technical assistance.
